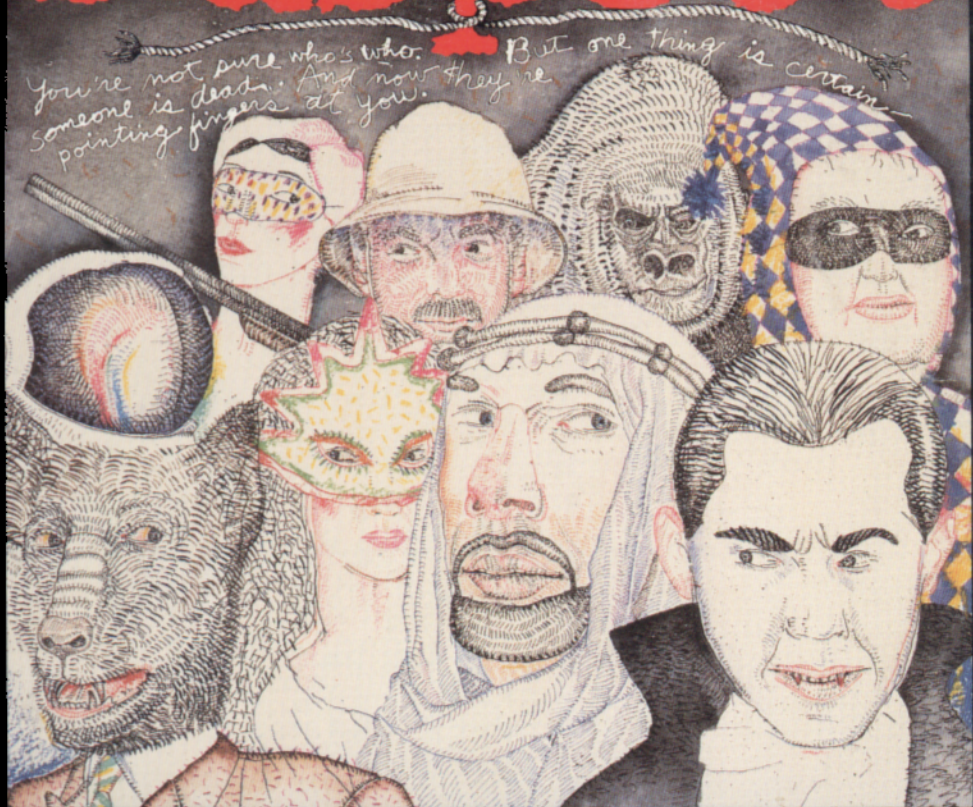

# Quitclaim Deed Great State of Maryland

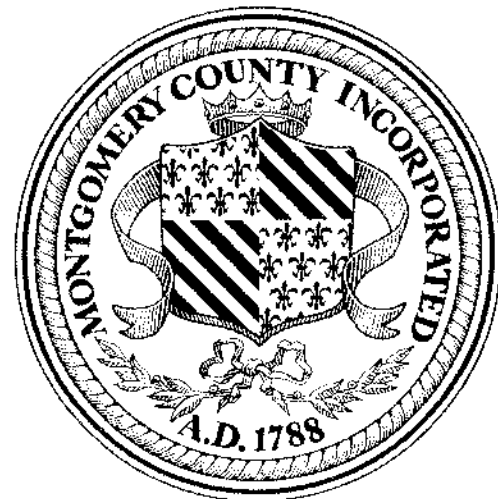
Know all men by these presents that I, Henry C. Ashcroft IV of Rappanoc in the County of Montgomery and Great State of Maryland in consideration of one dollar and other valuable considerations paid by my son Cyrus J. Ashcroft of said Rappanoc the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby remise, release, and forever quitclaim unto the said Cyrus J. Ashcroft, his heirs and assigns a certain parcel of land situated in said Rappanoc and now known as the Ashcroft Estate in said Rappanoc owned by the Ashcroft Trust and recorded with the Montgomery South District Deeds, Book of Plans no. 80 Said parcel of lands encompasses fully 134.8 acres bounded by Crofton Road to the south, the Allison Plantation to the east, The Milton Tarnauer Land Trust to the North, and the Baltimore Highway to the West.

To have and to hold the above granted premises with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging to the said Cyrus J. Ashcroft and his heirs, executors and administrators, covenant with the said grantee and his heirs and assigns that the granted premises are free from all incumbrances made or suffered by me, Henry C. Ashcroft IV and that I will and my heirs, and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said grantee and his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by, through, or under me, except as aforesaid but against none other.

And for the consideration aforesaid I, Constance W. Ashcroft, wife of said Henry C. Ashcroft IV do hereby release unto the said grantee and his heirs and assigns all right of or to both power and homestead in the granted premises.
